## **Small Boat Fleet**


#### - Holder and 420

- Lines are in a tote labeled "Small Fleet Hurricane Securing" (on the top shelf over the work bench)
- Remove all hull plugs
- Remove mast and boom re-attach connecting hardware to the rigging
- Place Holder and 420 booms in the Sunfish Sail rack, on top of the lower sail tubes
- Place the Holder and 420 masts on two foam blocks spanning two fence posts, secure both masts to the fence posts
- Secure the bow to the dolly
- Position boat sideways to the east fence, spanning two fence posts
- Secure line from low on aft fence post then under dolly strap and across the bow to be secured low on forward fence post



### - Sunfish and Laser (right side up)

- Lines are in the tote labeled "Small Fleet Hurricane Securing" (on the top shelf over the work bench)
- Remove all hull plugs
- Secure the bows to the dollies
- Position one boat sideways against the south fence spanning two fence posts
  - Secure line from low on forward fence post then under dolly strap and across the bow to be secured low on aft fence post
- · Position remaining boats between the ground anchors
  - Chock boats so that the aft is firmly against the ground
  - Secure first boat bow and dolly to the palm tree with long line
  - Run line around each dolly handle like it is a cleat and score to ground anchor on NE corner of Sunfish area
  - Secure red line from south to north over boat hulls, through ground anchor, over boat hull etc with red line
  - Secure line from NE corner anchor to N red line anchor



# **Boat Yard**

- Secure loose materials or store them inside of the shed
- Lock both doors to the shed
- Lock both gates with chains taught
- Remove all torn, plastic tarps
